Exercises: Terminals and Consoles

1. Open your first “virtual terminal” window:

Press the following key combination:

```
Alt-Ctrl-F1
```

What do you see?

Switch between virtual terminals 1 through 6. Once you are in a console window you can just press:

```
Alt-F[1-6]
```

to move between consoles.

Log in to a console as the user *pacnog*:

```
login: pacnog  
Password: <given in class>
```

Take a look at what processes are running on your machine:

```
$ ps auxwww
```

If you had to you could kill a process that might have hung your X session (Gnome) using the command:

```
$ sudo kill PID
```

or

```
$ sudo kill -9 kill PID
```

To return to Gnome (your GUI) press:

```
Alt-Ctrl-F7
```
