# Where does that lead?

- We have been seeing a trend for "server" type functions to move from remote sites to central sites for some time.
  - This will probably continue... but





## **Everyone Wins**

- Central sites are beginning to see the benefits of moving from central sites to "virtualised services"
  - And now the remote sites may get the benefits of being both centralised (I don't have to administer this anymore); and decentralised (the traffic doesn't have to go all the way to Sydney, the SP has a local presence here in Perth)
