Transfer from (Honiara) Henderson International Airport to Hotel

Honiara is located approximately 10 km (15 minutes' drive) away from Airport to Hotels in the City.

- The host will provide airport transfers, please notify Ms Wain Dakei (wain.dakei@telekom.com.sb) on your arrival and departure times.
- Alternatively, taxi and bus services are available. The approximate taxi fare from the airport to the city centre is SB\$100.00 (USD 13.80). It is ideal to catch a Cab than a Bus to Town.

Visa and Immigration Requirements

All visitors to Solomon Islands must have a valid passport for at least six (6) months beyond their intended length of stay in Solomon Islands and a ticket for return or onward travel to another country which he/she is authorized to enter. Most Pacific Islands countries are exempt from requiring a visa to enter Solomon Islands.

Insurance

We request you to make your own necessary arrangements for travel insurance and medical coverage before travel.

Departure Tax

The Departure Tax from the International Airport is SB\$400.00 per person (over 12 years) and is included in airfares.

Electricity

Electricity voltage is 230/240 volts with pin configuration similar to Australia and New Zealand. You are advised to take along your universal adaptor if you are from any other country with dissimilar pin configuration and voltages.

Currency

The local currency is Solomon Islands Dollars and Cents Exchange rates vary around USD 1.00 = SBD7.24. You can check the exchange rate at an Online Currency Converter on www.xe.com

Banks operating in Solomon Islands include: ANZ, Westpac, Bank of South Pacific, Pacific Oceanic Bank. Foreign cash, traveller's cheques and credit cards are widely accepted in Honiara and there were few ATM machines around the City.

Time

Local time in Solomon Islands is UTC +11 hours

Climate

Solomon Islands climate is tropical all year round, with two distinct seasons – the cooler/drier season running from May to October and the wetter/hotter season from November to April. Average daily temperature is 29 degrees Celsius. Light weight clothing plus a sweater is usually sufficient, year round.

The main port of entry into the Solomon Islands is at Henderson International Airport on the island of Guadalcanal; situated approximately 15 minutes' drive from the airport is the capital, Honiara.

The town lies on the northern coastline and has a small picturesque sea port at Point Cruz; you will enjoy the hustle and bustle of Honiara and the many things there is to see and do.

While Honiara is located on the wrong side of Guadalcanal Island where sandy beaches are in short supply, there are lots of great beaches and picnic spots along the western coast, most of which are located within 10 minutes of the capital.

Honiara is the Solomon Islands' springboard for tourism activities. The Solomon Islands Visitors Bureau is located on Honiara's main thoroughfare, Mendana Avenue and we provide tourist information and can radio ahead to announce visitors' arrivals to guest houses in the more remote areas. Honiara has a harbour from which ferries depart to the various provinces.
