## Background

- Accuracy of IRT contacts
- To engage APNIC Members to review and update registered IRT contacts every 6 months







#### Focus

- Aims to encourage accuracy of abuse contacts
  - Dedicated contacts or teams to resolve computer security incidents
  - Stops the tech-c and admin-c from getting reports of abuse
  - Efficient and accurate response
  - Shared response to address abuse

## **Actions required**

- Registered IRT contacts for an account are asked to review:
  - email contacts
  - abuse mailbox contacts
- Will receive an email every six months

Important: validate IRT contact

As of 30 June 2019, APNIC policy requires all IRT contact(s) to be validated every 6 months, and the IRT contact to demonstrate the abuse mailbox is monitored and responsive to legitimate abuse reports. Failure to validate within 15 days will result in the IRT whois object being marked as Invalid' and further action by APNIC to follow-up.

- Asia Pacific:
  - 12,225 email validation requests issued
  - 8,597 email validation requests confirmed
  - 70.3% confirmation rate

  - 171 email validation requests issued
  - 126 email validation requests confirmed
  - 73.68% confirmation rate

- 42 email validation requests issued

## Summary

- Validate your IRT contact every 6 months
- Other wise the following with happen:
  - your IRT object will be marked as **invalid** in the APNIC Whois Database
  - your MyAPNIC access restricted
- IRT validation can take place:
  - Clicking on the validation link sent to the IRT email contact, or
  - Update within MyAPNIC
